We also continue to work toward ways to increase the production. We want you to have the new uniform quickly, but without sacrificing quality. Current projections have orders taken the last week of September shipping over the next couple of months.

We welcome you to place your order now at the discounted price, knowing that most likely we will not be able to ship your

uniform until early 2018. The advantages of ordering now are the special pricing and that your request will be sent to the fulfillment department. Your order will ship as soon as it is available.
