## <u>The Election Day Process</u> Council #13042 - Election 5/26/22

• 3<sup>rd</sup> degree council members in good standing with the council interested in an officer position may be nominated by informing any member on the nominating committee (see names below). Self-nomination is acceptable, but if a council member is nominated by another council member, the nominating member must confirm his candidate is willing to accept and fulfill the duties and responsibilities of the office, if elected.

- Nominations for 3<sup>rd</sup> degree members in good standing with the council may also be made from the members attending the Business Meeting on May 26, 2022.
- If there are no CONTESTED Officer positions known at the May 26 business meeting, the Grand Knight will declare by acclamation the election of the recommended slate of Officers.
- If a Knight makes it known he will challenge an incumbent officer, or there are two or more nominations for an officer position, then a paper ballot will be used for that position only. The election process will follow as proscribed in the Council Bylaws. Ballots will be destroyed after the results have been certified.
