Year of St. Joseph

Dear Knights of Columbus members in Christ, this year is dedicated to St. Joseph by Pope Francis. There is only a little written about St. Joseph in the scriptures. But we could know the person and the personality of Joseph from the little that is written or within the silence of his character. Mathew's gospel presents him as 'a righteous man' (Mt 1.19). There is so much we can learn from his silence. For instance, his willingness to listen to the voice of God that came to him in a dream, his obedience and faithfulness to the call of God, proven by his willingness to endure hardships.

For this month's reflection, given the situation of ours, I want to reflect on the quality of '**patience**' through the life of St. Joseph. Patience is a willingness to suffer. A **patient** is one who suffers an illness not by choice, whereas, a **patient man/woman** is one who suffers voluntarily rather than relinquishes the vocation given him/her. Joseph was patient because of his love. He was willing to suffer anything, for instance leaving his place and taking shelter in a foreign land.

I think we all need to develop or practice the virtue of patience in our daily lives, particularly as we continue to remain lockdown. We may have to put up with family members and households, more than ever. This may be a period of trial in our relationships. St. Joseph comes as a model of patience that we need to endure and practice in our lives. Because things were difficult St. Joseph did not disown the call or the mission that was entrusted to him. So, we pray, through the intercession of St. Joseph:

Dear Lord,

You chose St. Joseph to be the earthly father of your Son and blessed him with patience and endurance. Give us the same gift of patience and endurance in our lives, as we continue through this difficult moment. May we continue to model St. Joseph in our own lives. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.


