# CHAPLAIN'S MESSAGE

One of my favorite symbols for this time of the year is the Christmas tree. When I visit a home for the first time, I often imagine where I would put a Christmas tree! In this busy season I like to take a few minutes at night with all the lights out except for the tree to sit in the stillness and ponder the gift of the infant Jesus to us.

Here is a beautiful story about the Christmas tree to reflect upon at this time. I found it in "The Catholic Source Book," by Rev. Peter Klein.

"St. Boniface was an eighth-century missionary (praised by Pope Gregory II) who brought Christianity to Germany. Returning to Germany later, he found that Christianity had not taken hold. On Christmas Eve he came upon the eldest son of the chieftain Gundhar being readied for sacrifice to the gods. The place was under the giant oak tree, sacred to their patron Thor. Boniface, in order to prove these gods powerless, felled the tree with the stroke of an ax, to the astonishment of the onlookers.

"When he was then asked for the word of God, Boniface proclaimed, 'This is the word, and this is the counsel. Not a drop of blood shall fall tonight, for this is the birth-night of the Saint Christ, Son of the all-Father and Savior of the world.' Pointing to a nearby evergreen he continued, 'This little tree, young child of the forest, shall be a home tree tonight. It is the wood of peace, for your houses are built of fir. It is the sign of endless life, for its branches are ever green. See how it points toward heaven. Let this be called the tree of the Christ Child. Gather about it, not in the wild woods but in your homes. There it will shelter no deeds of blood, but loving gifts and lights of kindness.""

In addition to giving us a deeper understanding of the Christmas tree, it also bears a pro-life message to remember in this holy season. Merry Christmas!




