CHAPLAIN'S MESSAGE

Every election cycle brings to the forefront the issues of life. Even between elections we have had the experience of talking to “Catholics” who say that they disagree with the Church’s stance on abortion. In other words, they are pro-choice. Recently some newspapers published an ad sponsored by so-called Catholics for Choice. The Bishops of New Jersey issued a very clear condemnation and clarification.

“The teaching of the Catholic Church on the sanctity of all human life – **especially life in the womb** – has been clearly and unequivocally expressed by Pope Francis, both during his papacy and as Cardinal Bergoglio:

*Life must be protected with utmost care from the first moment of conception: abortion and infanticide are abominable crimes.

*Abortion is without a doubt one of the greatest moral evils within modernity.

*The right to life is the first human right. Abortion is killing someone that cannot defend himself or herself.

YOU CANNOT BE CATHOLIC AND PRO-ABORTION. THE ONLY “CHOICE” FOR CATHOLICS IS LIFE!”

The statement could not be made any more clearly. This message was sponsored by the Catholic Bishops of New Jersey in response to a recent nationwide ad campaign by Catholics for Choice that misrepresents the Catholic Church’s teaching on abortion.

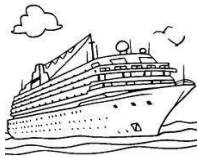

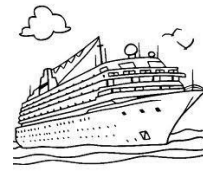
