CHAPLAIN'S MESSAGE

As a nation, we find ourselves doing some soul-searching. While I think it is healthy and constructive to study and learn from history, what I see happening I believe is unhealthy and destructive. I can't help but wonder if some day in the not too distant future there will be a discussion to change the name of our Order. After all, some would say the knights were Medieval male-chauvinists, and Columbus is now being called into question for his treatment of slaves and Native Americans.

While the Church, being a collection of sinners, has tragically had individuals who were prejudiced, every layer of her teachings and documents is against bigotry, hatred and violence. The Knights as defenders of the Church proclaim and defend the same Truth.

There are two aspects of the current controversy that deeply disturb me. The first is that there is no serious debate. There is no discussion between different points of view. I don't know if the name of our Order will ever come under scrutiny, but encourage all of us to simply continue to be true to the principles of our Order and our Church. There is no doubt that our country's past is not perfect and even includes embarrassing moments, but the same is true today. A better approach would be to work together to become better. The ultimate goal of our Order and of being Catholic is to be holy. To be holy is not be perfect or better than someone else, but as a sinner relying upon God's mercy, to use God's grace to become the best that He can make us!

INSURANCE MATTERS

Update Your Beneficiaries

Sometimes it is easy to overlook the simplest of things.

Take, for example, the beneficiaries on your life insurance policies. If your policy was applied for and issued several years ago, it may very well be that the person you originally selected as the beneficiary is no longer the person you would want to receive the policy proceeds. If you bought the policy when you were single, for example, you may have named your parents as beneficiaries. If you have since married, your policies should be updated to reflect your spouse as beneficiary. Maybe you've had children since, who are not named on the policies.

Most people list a primary beneficiary, who is specifically designated as the first in priority to receive policy proceeds. We also encourage the naming of a contingent beneficiary, an alternate person designated to receive policy proceeds, usually in the event that the original beneficiary pre-deceases the insured.

I routinely call all of my policyholders for annual review appointments, usually near the anniversary date of your policy – that is, the date it was originally issued. One of the matters that I'll discuss during this review is the status of your beneficiary designations. If they need updating, and they often do, I can complete the paperwork during that appointment.






