NOTICE OF MOTION

To proceed with the 2020 Cash Calendar project

The 2018 Cash Calendar project was a huge success for the Council and the Halton Columbus Charities. We sold 1,150 Calendars of the 1,200 printed and raised over \$10,000 for charity and approximately \$5,000 for the Council.

This program has an exposure to the Council of up to \$15,000. The main project costs are the calendar production of \$5,400. and the Cash Prizes of \$8,530. (total of \$13,930). A breakeven point is raising \$5,930. from sponsor ads and selling 400 Calendars (at \$20 per calendar), producing a total revenue of \$13,930. The 2018 Cash Calendar project raised approximately \$8,000. from sponsor ads and sold 1,150 calendars.

The motion made at the November 12 general meeting was to proceed with the 2020 Cash Calendar project.

This motion will be voted on at our December General Meeting on Monday, December 10, 2018.
