CAMPAIGN FOR PEOPLE WITH INTELLECTUAL DISABILITIES

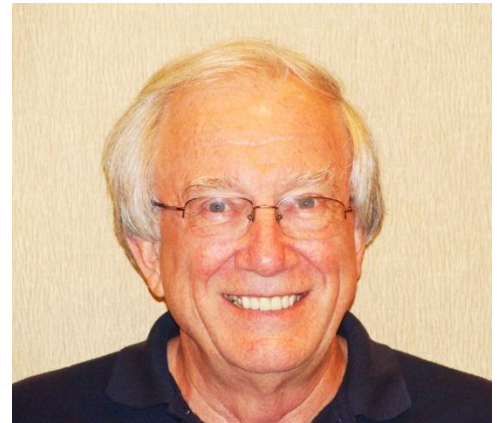

**OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE FRAMED IMAGE TOUR
ADRIAN DOMINGUEZ**

Cardinal James Francis Stafford, Major Apostolic Penitentiary Emeritus, and archbishop of Denver emeritus, was the principal celebrant at Votive Mass of Our Lady of Guadalupe on Wednesday, August 3rd, at the Supreme Convention in Denver, Colorado. Knights of Columbus state deputies stood before the altar at the end of the Mass holding their jurisdiction's framed image of Our Lady of Guadalupe, as Msgr. Eduardo Chavez explained the new Marian Prayer Program in which the images would be hosted by local councils worldwide during prayer services. The Guadalupe images were blessed by Pope Benedict XVI and touched to the tilma of Juan Diego which bears the miraculous image of Our Lady of Guadalupe. In addition, the frames of the images were sealed with soil from Tepeyac hill in Mexico, where Our



Lady's appearances took place. The new Knights of Columbus Marian Prayer Program will take place throughout the Order and lead into the second international Guadalupe Festival to be held at the Los Angeles Coliseum the weekend before the 2012 Supreme Convention. Supreme has blessed our state with two Our Lady of Guadalupe images and prayer books. Our jurisdiction has been separated by districts into two, East and West. The East District's (ED) consist of District's 03, 01, 13, 11, 07, 02 and 05. The West District (WD) consists of District's 10, 04, 08, 14, 09, 12 and 06. Our Lady of Guadalupe image will pilgrim through each district for at least one month starting with District 03 in the ED and District 10 in the WD. Each case containing the image of Our Lady of Guadalupe has a LOG BOOK in the side cover of the casing. This log must be filled out each time you have a prayer service/rosary and/or any gathering honoring Our Lady of Guadalupe. Please ensure the log book is kept with each image. We must return both set's at the end of the pilgrimage.

The District Deputy's will be responsible for ensuring the Our Lady of Guadalupe image pilgrims through their district. The District Deputy's coordinate with each Grand Knight the dates their council will have the image in their parish. Each Grand Knight will need to coordinate with their parish pastor's to ensure the image is displayed, at least one prayer service with the accompanied prayer books is made at each parish, one Rosary is said by the Knights and it is kept safe. Again, please ensure the log book is filled out for each event. The host council will then contact the next visiting council for date and time of delivery of Our Lady of Guadalupe image, prayer books, and log book. Please follow up with each Grand Knight receiving the Our Lady of Guadalupe image to ensure they are on schedule. Once the last council in your district is concluding their time with Our Lady of Guadalupe image, the DD will be responsible for contacting the next District Deputy to coordinate hand off.

I will be following up with each District Deputy at the beginning and end of each month to ensure we are on schedule. Our mission is to have both Our Lady of Guadalupe image's at our State Convention in April, at which a prayer service will be held on Sunday morning.

Please ensure all the prayer books are placed back into the traveling case with each Our Lady of Guadalupe image for the use of the following council. There are prayer cards which may be given to those who attend a prayer service, although limited. One of the follow up questions during my call will be the quantity of prayer cards left. I pray we can receive more from Supreme. We will see.

May Our Lady of Guadalupe keep you safe and watch over our pilgrimage of her image throughout our Arkansas Jurisdiction.

Brother Knights,

On October 17th, the County Commission in Shelby County, Tennessee, voted 9 to 4 to re-direct \$397,000 in Title X family planning funds to Christ Community Health Services instead of renewing a longtime contract with Planned Parenthood.



That means that—thanks to the hard work of pro-life Tennesseans who have been working to stop Planned Parenthood for years—Tennessee has completely defunded Planned Parenthood. It also means that our Scoreboard is now up to \$61 million tax dollars stripped from Planned Parenthood so far this year by nine states.

Between the good news in Tennessee, the recent passage of the Protect Life Act in the House of Representatives, and the congressional investigation of Planned Parenthood, momentum in the fight for Life is clearly on our side. Let's

keep this momentum going!

40 DAYS FOR LIFE

The importance and urgency of these 40 Days has been proven over and over again during previous campaigns and since it began again on September 28th of this year. Lives are being saved and there have been several lives saved right here in Arkansas.

Arkansas' Knights of Columbus adopted October 10th and the afternoon of November 2nd (12 Noon to 7:00 PM) to pray at the abortion clinic in Little Rock. If you were there, we thank you, as you joined in prayer with your Brother Knights, their wives and other family members and friends.

Of course, we all know that the Pro-Life effort begins with prayer and it has become evident that sometimes it makes a difference where those prayers are being offered. Many lives have been saved at the entrance to the abortion clinics around the country, because there were sidewalk prayer warriors praying the Rosary, or Divine Chaplet, or general prayers when a pregnant mother arrived for an abortion. Other results around the country have seen clinics shut down in several states, And, as a result of thousands of Pro-Life supporters, writing and calling their state and federal government officials on behalf of the "not yet delivered" babies, new Pro-Life laws are being passed around the country. But, not enough, not yet! We need your help.

Please go to the Knights of Columbus website and refer to the "culture of Life" page, for information on what you can do to help. In the meantime, please ask your Council members to step up and be counted in the Pro-Life movement. Ask them to commit to at least one hour praying at the abortion clinic in Little Rock or Fayetteville. 40 Days For Life ends soon and that just means that we have the other 325 days of the year for us to be there in prayer and action.

Please, Brother Knights, let's be there for God's Babies. In speaking with two Brother Knights who were out in prayer to end abortion for the first time, with their wives, they shared with us the joy and blessing they felt in being there.

When our days on earth end, let not we be asked, "Where were you when my children were being brutally murdered by abortion?"

It was with much regret that I had to postpone the exemplification at Harrison that was scheduled for October 22nd. But with only 6 candidates I really had no choice. We really need 20 or more candidates to put on the degree. When all the degree team has to travel some distance and stay at the hotel plus mileage, that must come from the income of the degree, which is part of the \$70.00 and income from the banquet. Also from the \$70.00 comes the banquet ticket, \$12.00 goes to Supreme Council \$13.50 for the candidates baldrick and lapel pin.



In short I am asking your assembly to help us work to get more candidates for the next scheduled date at the Same place of our new assembly at Harrison, Mary, Mother of God Assembly 3306. With hunting season here then winter coming on, we are looking for a date in March or the 14th of April. When we get the date firmed up I will let you know.

On another note, Supreme Council has initiated a request for our help in creating a scholarship fund for seminarians that will pledge to serve some years as a military chaplain. There is a very low percentage of Catholic priests serving in the military for our service men. Our state is asked to raise \$4,000.00 each year for 5 years for a total of \$20,000.00. This is included with the state

councils for the total. I will be sending each Navigator a letter along with an explanation letter from the Vice Supreme Master of Florida who is in charge of the campaign over this section of the country. All individual checks will be sent to him and names will be printed in a report of recognition of individuals by state. As I said this is not only 4th degree included in this, but first second and third degree are included also.

The blessed Mother promised to restore her health and said to her: 'Whoever wishes to receive favors from me should make three novenas of the prayers of the rosary in petition and three in thanksgiving.'"

To obtain a favor, pray consecutively 6 nine day rosary novenas (27 days of petition and 27 days of thanksgiving), alternating mysteries.

7. Whoever shall have a true devotion for the rosary shall not die without the sacraments of the Church.
8. Those who are faithful to recite the rosary shall have during their life and at their death the light of God and the fullness of His graces, and at the moment of death they shall participate in the merits of the saints in paradise.
9. I shall deliver from purgatory those who have been devoted to the rosary.
10. The faithful children of the rosary shall merit a high degree of glory in heaven.
11. You shall obtain all you ask of me by the recitation of the rosary.
12. All those who propagate the holy rosary shall be aided by me in their necessities.

NATIONAL RIGHT TO LIFE APPLAUDS U.S. HOUSE APPROVAL OF PROTECT LIFE ACT, SLAMS PRESIDENT OBAMA FOR THREAT TO PROTECT ABORTION SUBSIDIES WITH VETO

WASHINGTON – By a [bipartisan vote of 251-172](#), the U.S. House of Representatives today approved the Protect Life Act (H.R. 358), a bill to nullify the multiple abortion-expanding provisions of the 2010 federal health care law ("ObamaCare").

On October 5, Secretary of Health and Human Services Kathleen Sebelius vehemently defended the 2010 health care law in a speech to a NARAL Pro-Choice America fundraiser, saying 'we are in a war' with critics of the law. On October 12, the White House issued a formal veto threat against the Protect Life Act. **"President Obama won enactment of ObamaCare in 2010 partly by pretending that the bill did not expand abortion -- but now the mask is coming off,"** said NRLC Legislative Director Douglas Johnson.

In an October 6 letter to U.S. House members, NRLC noted that the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA, Public Law 111-148, "ObamaCare") ". . . contained multiple provisions that provide authorizations for subsidies for abortion, both implicit and explicit, and also multiple provisions that opened doors to abortion-expanding administrative actions." The Protect Life Act would prohibit the use of any PPACA-authorized funds for abortions or to subsidize health plans that cover abortions, except to save the life of the mother, or in cases of rape or incest. The Protect Life Act would not restrict the sale or purchase of insurance coverage for abortion with non-federal funds.

During today's debate, opponents of the bill repeatedly claimed that it would allow hospitals to deny women "emergency" abortions. In reality, the bill does not change the longstanding federal law in question, called EMTALA, which requires that in an "emergency" a hospital must do its best to stabilize both the pregnant mother and her "unborn child" (which is the term used in the statute). The Protect Life Act allows federal funding of an abortion required to save a mother's life.

The Protect Life Act is sponsored by Congressman Joe Pitts (R-Pa.) and Congressman Dan Lipinski (D-Ill.). On today's vote on passage, the bill was supported by 236 Republicans and 15 Democrats. It was opposed by 170 Democrats and two Republicans.

NRLC's Douglas Johnson presented detailed information on the abortion-expanding provisions of ObamaCare, and regarding the need for the Protect Life Act, in testimony before the Subcommittee on Health of the Committee on Energy and Commerce on February 9, 2011: www.nrlc.org/AHC/ProtectLifeActDouglasJohnsonTestimony.pdf.

Founded in 1968, the National Right to Life Committee (NRLC), the federation of 50 state right-to-life affiliates and more than 3,000 local chapters, is the nation's oldest and largest national grassroots pro-life organization. Recognized as the flagship of the pro-life movement, NRLC works through legislation and education to protect innocent human life from abortion, infanticide, assisted suicide and euthanasia.
