College Scholarship fund for Catholic Education

Locally a K of C council awards scholarships annually. Funds disbursed are designated exclusively for the purpose of providing college scholarships to students applying for a full-time undergraduate program.

The applicant must be a US citizen applying for or in a full-time undergraduate program leading to a bachelor's degree at a **Catholic college** or **Catholic university** in the United States.

The applicant must be a Catholic in good standing and a parishioner, son or daughter of a parishioner, of a Catholic church **located in Lake County, Illinois.**

These scholarships will be awarded in amounts of at least \$2,000.

Completed applications must be received by **April 1, 2018**. It is the applicant's responsibility to make sure the recommendation form is turned in by the appropriate deadline. Although it is not required, the student can submit a short (less than 1 page) essay on why this scholarship would be valuable to receive extra points.


